## Shah Alam City Council to expand waste separation

**SHAH ALAM:** Separation of solid waste at source will be enforced at five other locations under the jurisdiction of the Shah Alam City Council (MBSA) effective next month.

MBSA head of corporate and public relations division Shahrin Ahmad said the new places were Section 19, Section 24, Section 31, Section U5 and Section U10, involving 1,500 houses.

He said the solid waste separation programme had been carried out since October last year, beginning with Section 7, Section 32, Section U8, Section U13 and Section U16.

The first three months after October saw about 15,076 tonnes of recyclables collected from the affected areas, he said.

Under the solid waste separation programme, he said, residents would be provided with biodegradable plastic bags to separate their household waste based on categories like plastic, paper, glass and aluminium.

Shahrin said the solid waste separation programme was carried out with the intention of educating the public to make recycling a culture.

We have yet to issue summonses or compounds against residents who failed to separate their household waste, he added. **Bernama**
