'Pay' using recyclables to enter MBSA run next Sunday

TAKING its green initiative a step further, Shah Alam City Council (MBSA) is collecting recycled materials as entry fee for its 2017 Recycling Run.
Participants can register with either 10 newspapers, seven one-litre and 15 500ml plastic bottle caps, 15 aluminium cans or 15 drink packets of any size.
The April 16 run is jointly organised by MBSA and Fraser & Neave Holdings Bhd (F&N) in conjunction with the Shah Alam Car

Free Day and the 2017 Earth Day celebration. It will be flagged off from Dataran Kemerdekaan Shah Alam.
MBSA corporate communications head Shahrin Ahmad hopes to inculcate love for nature in city folk and encourage a healthy lifestyle in the process.
"We want recycling to become part of their daily lives, a habit if possible. Only then can we achieve a green sustainable environment," he added.

The council advocated a green and healthy lifestyle over the past few years and planned to achieve the Shah Alam Low Carbon City by 2030.
MBSA aims to reduce its carbon footprint by 45%.
Interested participants can bring the items to the Waste Management and Public Cleansing Department on Level 4, Wisma MBSA.
For those living outside the MBSA jurisdic-

tion, the council made provisions for participants to bring their "entry fees" from 6am onwards.
Registration for the 5km run is open to all Malaysians aged 17 and above.
The first 1,000 participants will receive a free T-shirt, a numbered sticker and certificate.
