## Selangor Sultan and consort attend car-free day

SHAH ALAM: The Sultan Selangor and his consort attended the Shah Alam City Council's (MBSA) Car-Free Day and Earth Day celebration at Dataran Kemerdekaan Shah Alam in Seksyen 14 here Sunday.

Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah and Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin arrived at about 9am.

Accompanying the royal couple were Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Mohamed Azmin Ali and Shah Alam mayor Datuk Ahmad Zaharin Mohd Saad.

Together with the state leaders, Sultan Sharafuddin and Tengku Permaisuri Norashikin then launched an electric car and an electric bus, which would replace a diesel-powered bus to provide free public transport service in the city.

They also visited the 60 participating stalls in the Eco Free

Market, where used items still in good condition were being given away.

Earlier at 7am, Azmin flagged off a running and cycling event to promote recycling before he joined other state leaders in a 5km walk.

The crowd was in a festive mood as people rode bicycles, roller blades, skateboards, scooter blades and hover boards, while others enjoyed walking or running on the closed roads.

Roads that were closed for the event from 6am to noon were Persiaran Bandaraya, Persiaran Perbandaran, Persiaran Tasik, Persiaran Dato Menteri, Persiaran Masjid and Persiaran Damai.
